MANAGER'S REPORT

There have been a couple projects approved down at Sunset Park. The first one is replacing the rope fence with a split rail fence. This will be a three rail fence for safety reasons. The second project will be to add a fish cleaning station to the new dock area. This was approved at the November Board meeting. Plans are being made now. To go along with the fish cleaning we will be adding lights for the water area. Both projects will be complete in the beginning of December.

Sealcoating has been a slower process than planned. We had to change the formula for better adhesion on the roads. Project should be complete by December 1st.

Back office renovation has been approved. Work will be started by December 1st on the upgrade.

A Committee has been set up for Exterior of Clubhouse renovation. The first of many meetings has been set up commencing on November 18th.

Welcome back to all that just arrived. Looking forward to seeing the rest of the Harbor Lights residents soon.



HARBOR LIGHTS COOPERATIVE,INC. OF DIRECTORS MEETING THURSDAY, November 12, 2015 9:00 AM IN THE CLUBHOUSE

- 1. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM by President Sandwick.
- ROLL CALL: Dellina, Fox, Laughlin, Lewis, Pettengill, Sandwick and Wallace were present. Young joined telephone conference at 9:20 AM. Bunnell absent. Wisdom present for Management. 43 shareholders were present.
- 3. CONFIRMATION AND POSTING: The meeting was duly posted and a quorum was present.
- 4. READING OF THE MINUTES:
 - A. Board of Directors Budget Workshop Meeting Minutes of 10-07-15 were read into the minutes.
 - B. Board of Directors Meeting Minutes of 10-08-15 not read as all Directors had a copy. There were no corrections or additions.
 Motion by Pettengill, second by Wallace to approve minutes.
 Unanimous vote to accept.
 - C. Board of Directors Budget Workshop Meeting Minutes of 10-09-15 were read into the minutes.

5. MANAGER'S REPORT

- A. 2016 Budget Wisdom went over proposed changes. Motion made by Lewis, second by Laughlin to send the 2016 budget out to the shareholders for approval. Fox voted "nay". Motion carried.
- B. Changes to Rules and Regulations Wisdom went over changes and revisions. Discussion followed regarding change to Residency II-D requiring that the owner of two properties must reside in one of them for at least 90 days in a calendar year and also II-E regarding background check on renters and whether this should apply to those renting for more than 61 days or if it should apply to all renters. A legal opinion will be sought on these issues. All other changes are just a matter of spelling or punctuation.

Motion by Dellina, seconded by Wallace to accept recommendations of Rules and Regulations Committee as written except for II RESIDENCY D AND E. Unanimous approval.

C. Fish Station at New Dock - A fish cleaning table with sink and running water, fish pole holders and an electric light shining down on the water have been requested per written comments in the office and a petition with 46 signatures. Motion made by Pettengill, seconded by Wallace to approve spending up to \$1,500 to fulfill the request. Lewis voted "nay". Motion carried.

6. TREASURER'S REPORT - Pettengill reported fixed assets as of Oct. 31, 2015 at \$4,809,154.83 and total savings, checking and cash at \$862,573.67. Motion by Dellina with second by Lewis to approve the Treasurer's Report. Unanimous approval.

7. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

A. Club House Exterior Renovation Committee will meet on November 18, 2015 at 9:00 AM in the Club House. Anyone may attend.

8. UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- A. Storage Yard Plans are being made regarding how to utilize available space to best accommodate 9 people waiting for boat spaces and 15 waiting for storage sheds.
- B. Road Update on Seal Coating Many problems have arisen with the seal coating and the company has assured that problems will be straightened out. Nothing has been paid as yet and there is an 18 month warranty. Sandwick and Wisdom will be meeting with the owner of the company today and will determine what further action needs to be taken.
- C. 25th Anniversary Update Young reports they are planning a 2-3 day celebration and have a place for the banquet. Everyone is to pay for their own meal. This Board has agreed to contribute \$1,000 toward the celebration and hopefully the Recreation Board will contribute also.
- D. Cookbook has gone to print.

9. NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Discussion on Financing Lot #124 Regarding the possibility of the Board putting a package together and looking for approval to put a house on the lot and sell it, a legal opinion will be obtained.
- B. Backflow Prevention Update Sandwick has been in touch with the new person in charge of Venice Utilities and more information is needed.

 A field person will be sent out to assess the situation. In the meantime, Sandwick recommends that shareholders do not contact the City of Venice nor a plumber. The 30 day period to have the work done will be extended and it is hoped it will be possible to find a plumber who will do the work for the whole park all at once. This is a Florida State law, City of Venice Ordinance and Sarasota County Ordinance.
- 10. SHAREHOLDER'S COMMENTS: A request was made that the garbage disposal in the kitchen be replaced. It was removed because it was not working properly and was leaking.
- 11. ADJOURNMENT: Motion by Dellina with second by Pettengill to adjourn the

meeting at 10:54 AM. Unanimous vote to approve.
